BRIEF HISTORY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF BENGALI:



Bengali is one of the first Department of the College to introduce Honours Course from the Academic Session 2015-2016 for considering the necessity and demand of the students of the rural area mostly belonging to backward classes and first-generation learners. Since the establishment the Department have been active constantly in serving the students. The Department is constantly engaged in encouraging students to introduce them to the rich and diverse world of Bengali literature. The faculty consists of one Assistant Professor and three State Aided College Teachers (SACT) out of whom three have obtained Ph. D Degree and qualified UGC NET/SET Examination.

After passing out from the Department of Bengali of Nathaniyal Murmu Memorial College, many students got the opportunity to take admission in M.A. regular course at Visva Bharati University, North Bengal University, Gour Banga University and other higher educational institutions and they have obtained M.A. degree from many of them have qualified UGC NET/SET Examination and some of them have got the opportunity for Ph. Many students of the Department have achieved their goal and have been providing their valuable services to the Society as State Police, Kolkata Police, Nursing Staff, CIVIC Volunteer, Bank employee, Block Development Office Staff and Political Personalities.
